### **English**

Our literacy topic will be **stories with familiar settings** such as shops, post offices and place that we know in local town centres.

We will focus on specific phonics each week to build our skills in letters and sounds. We will also practise our mark making skills using a range of sensory materials and hand gym activities. We will of course continue reading our books at least 3 times a week in order to build reading skills and record reading logs in the yellow home books. The children will bring their reading log prizes home on a Thursday if they have collected 10 new reading logs.

### **Mathematics**

In number lessons the children will get to work with a range of resources such as number lines, counting animals and number grids. These will support their recognition of numbers, adding, the concept of more and place value. In data handling we will complete tables, tally charts and a bar graph to show the results of data collected about the number of boys and girls in class, our eye colour and our hair colour.
