English



In English this term we will be focussing our writing lessons around Myths and Legends. We will be describing different characters and settings, reading ancient Egyptian myths and legends and designing our own Egyptian Gods.

We will continue to learn phonics on Mondays, Social Skills on Tuesdays, Reading Comprehension on Wednesdays, Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar on Thursdays and Writing on Fridays.

Maths



In Maths this term our focus in Number will include number bonds, odd and even numbers, using a calculator to help us solve addition and subtraction problems, rounding numbers and finding the difference between two groups of objects. Our topic lessons will focus on 3D shapes and their properties.
