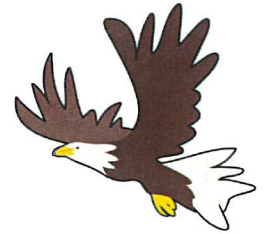




Eagle Class Newsletter

Eagle Class topic

- ✚ Use the internet to look at key buildings such as the Colosseum or the Baths.
