Foundation	“Pirates”	<p>Communication, language & literacy Explore & respond to water play: signing / talking to peers & adults. Respond and use “what” & “where” questions in water play. Listen & respond to stories about lakes, the sea, rivers etc. Use water related vocabulary to label items and identify position or place eg. “boat is in the sea”. KS1	“Pirates”	<p>Poetry, pattern & rhyme Listen to and respond to water based poems & rhymes. Use water related vocabulary in speech & when labelling pictures eg. lake Identify rhyming words and join in with refrains or sounds in poems. Begin to talk about their likes/ dislikes in a poem & what they remember. Make lists of rhyming words and begin to compose simple phrases/ poem.</p>	<p>Develop phonics/letter sounds knowledge To recognise letters & words in simple books. Develop handwriting skills Develop speech & language/Narrative Approaches</p>
Yr 3 & 4	“Mr Bloom’s Greenhouse”	<p>Non-chronological reports Identify types of non-fiction and fiction books. Understand that a book’s subject can be found via the picture, title, “blurb”. Use books or a search engine to find out facts eg. healthy eating Make lists of “facts” with words or symbols about a topic. Compose simple reports using words, pictures & symbols.</p>	<p>Read words & phrases in books Develop handwriting & spelling. Use Clicker 6. Develop use of phonics & decoding. Develop Speech & language/ Narrative Approaches</p>
Yr 5 & 6	“Jet Setters”	<p>Adventure & letters Listen to and re-tell parts of an adventure story, identifying plot, characters, atmosphere etc. Be able to talk about & compose character studies. Role play or use puppets to tell parts of a story. Understand the main features of a letter. Compose short letters from or to characters in a story.</p>	<p>Use Speech & language skills effectively Develop spelling/ phonics. Use relevant websites & search engines. Develop creative writing Develop handwriting skills leading to cursive writing.</p>
