Dear Parents / Carers,

Here are a few things we would like to share with you about Rabbit Class and our learning:

We are happy to let you know that Amy Smith (teacher) will be returning from maternity leave to join Rabbits from Monday 18th March. Amy will be in class Mondays, Tuesday afternoons and Wednesdays.

Our Topic and learning

The Rabbits topic this half term is called 'Shopping'. We will be role playing going to the shops, sorting items into different types of shops and going to the local shop to buy food for a picnic.

In Literacy we will be focusing on finding named objects, answering questions involving action words and drawing different lines and letters in writing.

In phonics, we will be identifying and copying sounds, learning about the letter sounds s, a, t, p, i, n and blending sounds to read short words.

In Mathematics we will be counting, identifying one more and one less, sorting into sets and comparing amounts. We will also be thinking about size and weight.

In PE we will be using the large equipment and in cooking we will be practicing our chopping skills. In music we will be thinking about volume and speed and in art and technology we will be exploring photography.

Continuing learning

To supporting and continue your child's learning at home, here are some ideas of activities:

- Make a shopping list and find items to put in the basket / trolley when you go shopping. Help the children to be involved in handing over money and packing the bags.
- Help to look after any plants you have at home. Can they water them.
- Label actions such as jumping, walking, eating. Ask questions such as "who is eating?" Can they point or label that person.
- Get your child involved in food preparation - can they use a safe knife to chop soft foods.

This half term Rabbit class will be walking to the local shop to buy food for a picnic.
