Our Topic and learning

The Rabbits topic this half term is called 'Magic School Bus. We will be looking at going places, and exploring the school grounds to compare it to winter time.

We are beginning with personal safety week this week, looking at asking for help, the people who help us, our body parts and understanding that our private parts need to be covered by pants.

In Literacy we will be focusing on stories based on journeys, joining in with repeated phrases in stories and sequencing them. In phonics, we will be continuing to learn the letter sounds s, a, t, p, i, n and blending sounds to read short words. In writing we will be focusing on hold writing tools and making written marks with meaning.

In Mathematics we will be counting, taking objects away from a set, sorting into sets, comparing amounts, sharing and doubling and identifying numbers. We will also be thinking about Shape and colour focusing on sorting objects of the colours

To supporting and continue your child's learning at home, here are some ideas of activities:

- Travel on different transport
- Visit different local environments
- Make marks using different writing tools - brushes, pens, chalks
- Look for numbers in the environment
